The Renal Ward is located in the Churchill Hospital in the Oxford Kidney Unit. We are just in front of Car Park 2.

We provide a regional renal service for Oxfordshire, Buckinghamshire and Swindon. Complex medicine regimes, invasive renal investigations, renal replacement therapy and palliative care are just some of the routine activities performed by the nursing team.
