Gastroenterology and Hepatology Ward

Gastroenterology and Hepatology Ward is located on 7F and we have a 20 bedded inpatient ward providing specialist gastroenterology and hepatology services to Oxford University Hospitals at the John Radcliffe Hospital.

The ward has a wide patient demographic with complex conditions being managed daily. Patients are admitted to 7F with crohns, colitis, liver cirrhosis, liver disease, hepatic encephalopathy, eating disorders, intestinal failure and for nutritional support such as parental and enteral feeding. Patients are admitted from other hospitals as well to establish parental feeding before they are discharged into the community. The ward takes a multidisciplinary approach always ensuring the best outcome for all patients.

There are a range of opportunities for you to work alongside the multidisciplinary teams. The ward works closely with our day case unit, endoscopy, IBD nurses, hepatology specialist nurses, alcohol liaison nurses, nutrition team, stoma nurses, line team and dietitian.

The ward shifts are long days and nights. Long days are 7am till 8pm and night shifts are 7.30pm till 7.30am.
