1. The bandings of each post:

d) In August 2012?

1a. N/A - FY1 doctors are on an out of hour's rota; they work days only, which does not attract a banding supplement.

2. Please let me know the month/year when hours monitoring occurred for such posts for each of the past 5 years.

2a. No monitoring has taken place.

3. If there was any change in the bandings for such posts between 2012 and 2015, please let me know when any/all such changes occurred and which posts this was for.

3. There have been no changes that we are aware of.

4. Were there any requests for hours monitoring made by any junior doctor at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre in August 2012-Feb 2013? I do not need any names - just a yes or no.

4a. Not known - we do not have a record of monitoring requests made by a junior doctor at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre during this period.
