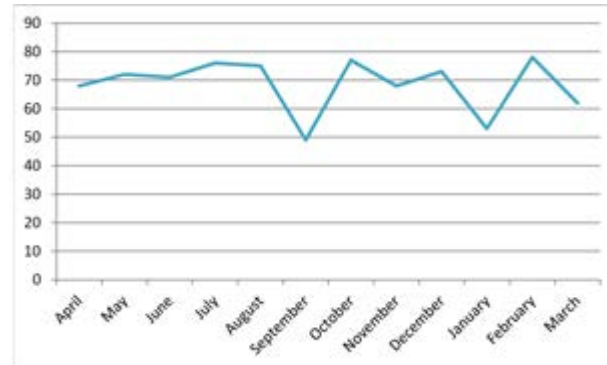


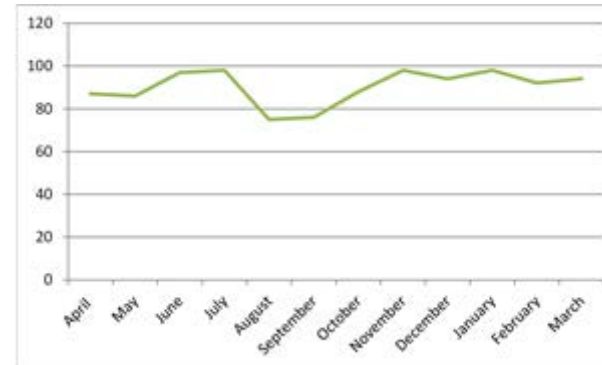

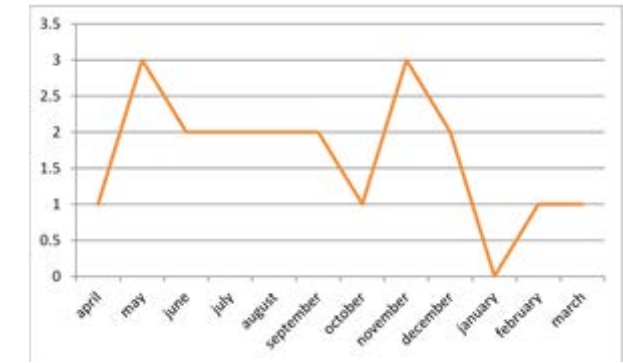

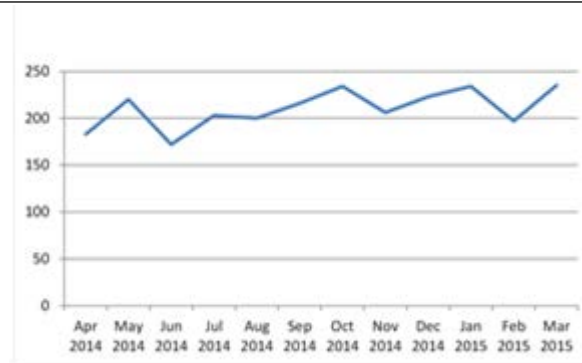
1) Number of Medication Administration Error or Concern.



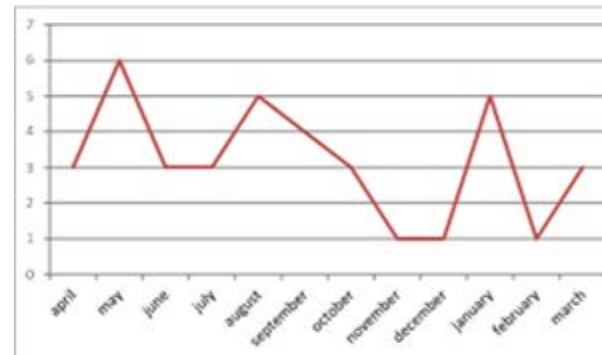
2) Number of All Hospital Acquired Pressure Ulcers.



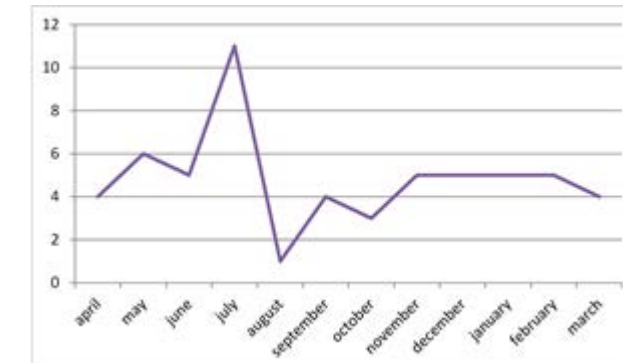
3) Number of Avoidable Grade 3-4 Hospital Acquired Pressure Ulcers SIRI.



4) Number of All Patient Falls

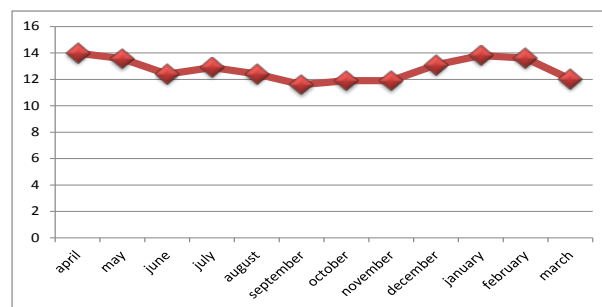


5) Number of Patient Falls With Moderate, Major and Catastrophic Harm.

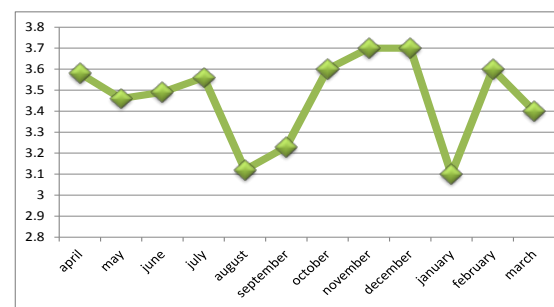

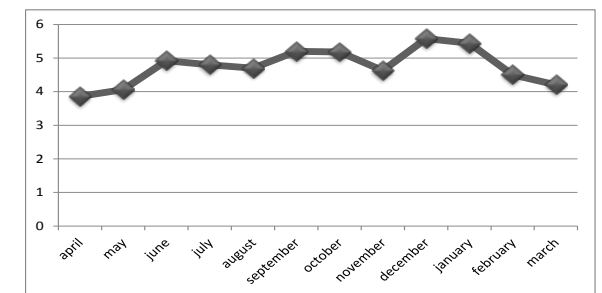
