

Discharged Home



Up to 1 week post discharge

Telephone follow-up from Stoma nurse to check progress

Up to 2 weeks

Telephone consultations

6-8 weeks

Template review (either via telephone consultation or clinic appointment)

(3 months)

Phone call from Stoma nurse if required

6 months

Telephone follow-up from Stoma nurse to check progress

12 Months

Clinic appointment at the JR, Churchill or satellite clinics at Abingdon, Banbury or Witney
