


Orthotics

What is Orthotics?

The Orthotics service provides a wide range of devices which are designed to align, prevent and improve deformities as well as improving the function of joints in the body.

What your orthosis is called

What to do after you are discharged

Once you have been discharged, if you are still using the Orthosis then please contact the Orthotics Department if any problems arise. If you do not have any issues, then you do not need to get in contact.

Even though you have been discharged from the hospital, you remain on a 5 year open review with the Orthotics Department in Oxford, which means that you have not been discharged from our service.

If you are from outside the Oxfordshire area, it is likely more convenient for you to see an Orthotics service closer to you, for this you would need a new referral to be seen. However, you can still be seen by our department as you will be on an open review.
