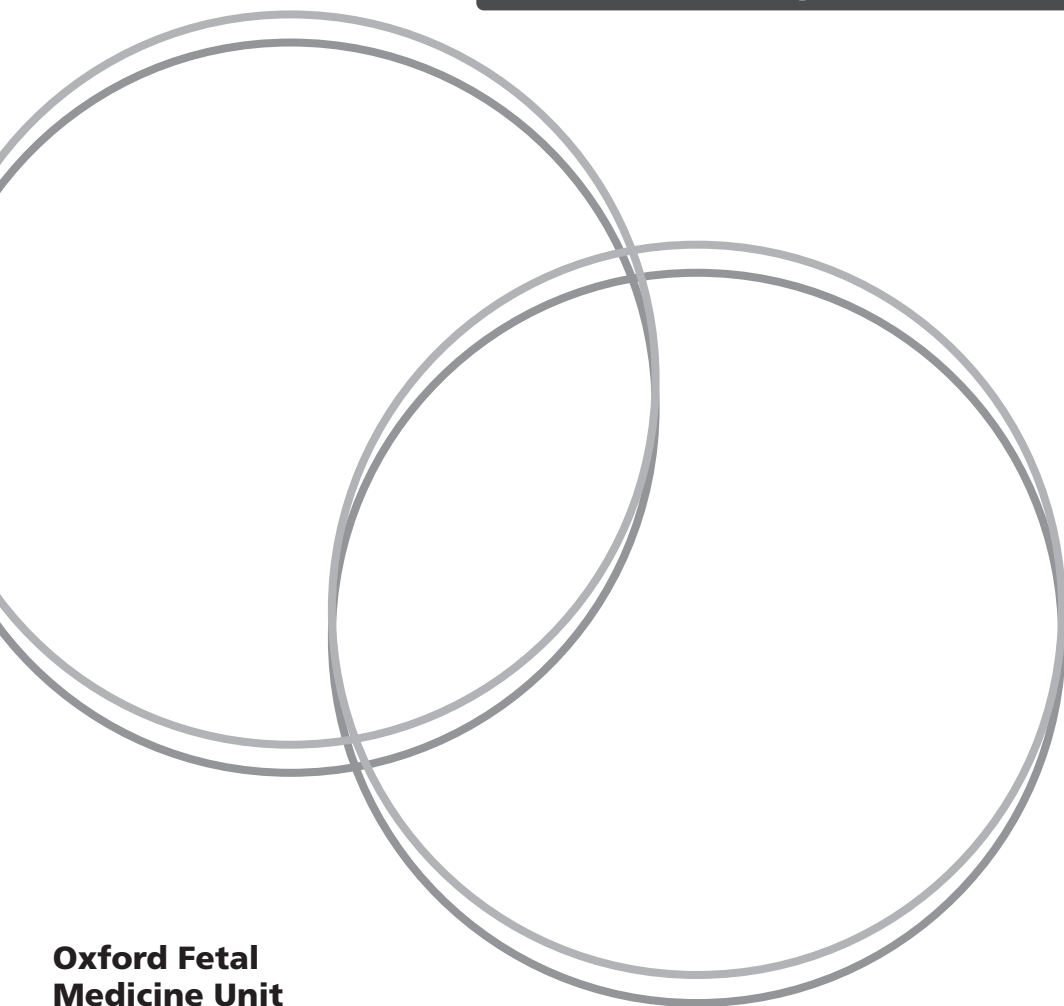


Referral to Oxford Fetal Medicine Unit (FMU)

Referral to Fetal Medicine Unit

You have been referred for further assessment of your baby following your scan today. The Fetal Medicine Unit (FMU) is made up of a team of doctors and midwives who specialise in the medical care of babies before they are born. Your referral will be assessed promptly and you will be contacted by phone within 3 working days to discuss an appointment.

At this appointment you will meet a senior obstetrician (a doctor who specialises in pregnancy, birth and the time after birth) who will scan your baby and discuss the results with you.
