# What do I need to know?

- Community care will continue with your local community midwife or GP surgery
- Your anomaly scan will take place on Level 4 of the Women's Centre
- All other scans happen in the Fetal Medicine Department with a Fetal Medicine Consultant, on Level 6

**For all URGENT queries** including suspected labour or health and wellbeing concerns for you or your babies:

- State that you are a Fetal Medicine patient with monochorionic twins.

**For NON-URGENT queries** including appointment changes or scan queries:

 Please call the Fetal Medicine Midwifery Team on: 01865 221716 (Mon-Fri, 08.30-17.30)

**For ALL OTHER NON-URGENT or routine pregnancy queries** such as blood results, routine pregnancy care and advice including diet, physio or vaccines:

• Please contact your **Community Midwifery Team**.
