

The Rainbow Clinic

The term 'rainbow pregnancy' is used by many families to describe a pregnancy following a pregnancy loss or neonatal death.

The Rainbow Clinic is a specialist service for women who are expecting a baby, having previously experienced a late miscarriage, stillbirth or neonatal death. It will support you and your family or support network through your pregnancy.

Becoming pregnant after a previous loss can be a worrying and daunting prospect. The Rainbow Clinic will provide you and your family with continuity of carer, in partnership with your community midwifery teams.

Your medical history will determine if you need wider support from specialist services. If you are under the care of the Fetal Medicine Unit or Pre-term Clinic, our Rainbow Clinic team can still support you.

Our model of care is based on the Rainbow Clinic in Manchester, which found that care from a small team of experts reduces anxiety and unnecessary checks by healthcare professionals who may not know your story.

What to expect

Our team comprises two Bereavement Specialist Midwives, a Bereavement Maternity Support worker and a Lead Obstetric Consultant.

We will work closely with you, your family and your community midwife to provide you with dedicated time and support that is tailored to your needs.

- 18-20 week scan
- 28 week appointment
- 32 week appointment
- 36 week appointment
