

SHARED CARE TEAMS FOR CHILDREN WITH INHERITED BLEEDING DISORDERS

Below is a list of the lead Consultant Paediatricians at surrounding local DGH's linked to Oxford Children's Haemophilia Centre, along with their contact details. The role of the lead is to ensure that notes and Open Door Access are in place should patients require emergency admission to their local hospital. The local hospital will have copies of all the letters from the CCC in Oxford and know who to contact for management advice. The local lead consultant is not required to see the child for regular clinic review, as they are seen in Oxford regularly. If the child has other paediatric issues managed locally then the local lead will inform Oxford.
